

Kentucky Energy Efficient Appliance Rebate Program



Introduction

Guide for Kentucky Residents

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 appropriated funds to each state for the establishment and administration of appliance rebate programs. The amount available to Kentucky residents is \$4,096,000. This is a first come, first served rebate program that does not apply retroactively (if an appliance is purchased before the program launch date of April 22, it does not qualify for a rebate). Kentucky residents who replace an existing appliance from an eligible category with a new ENERGY STAR qualified appliance after April 22, 2010 may apply for the rebate. Approved applicants will receive a Visa® Prepaid card via mail.

A goal of the program is to stimulate the economy by encouraging consumers to replace old appliances with new energy efficient models. We invite Kentuckians to participate in this program and thank you for doing your share to protect our natural resources and boost Kentucky's economy.

Q & A

When does the program start and end?

This program begins on April 22, 2010 and ends the instant the funds run out. We expect the program to generate much interest and encourage participants to act quickly.

Who is eligible?

A Kentucky resident with a valid Kentucky residential address who replaces an existing appliance with a new eligible ENERGY STAR qualified appliance and follows the program's requirements. All rebates will be mailed to the residential address, with no exceptions. PO Boxes are not accepted.

How do I recognize an ENERGY STAR qualified appliance?

All appliances that have earned the ENERGY STAR certification feature the familiar logo on the front of the product and on the product packaging. If you are unsure, ask a sales associate or visit www.ENERGYSTAR.gov for a complete list of ENERGY STAR products and models.

Who is administering the Kentucky Energy Efficient Appliance Rebate Program?

The Kentucky Energy Efficient Appliance Rebate Program is funded by the Kentucky Department for Energy Development and Independence through the U.S. Department of Energy's American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funding.

May I receive a rebate for more than one appliance?

Kentucky residents may apply for one rebate per appliance category per address. For example, one refrigerator plus one dishwasher rebate would qualify. Applications for two dishwasher rebates would not qualify.

How will applications be verified?

Every rebate application will be audited to verify the qualifying purchase and other requirements.

How do I apply for the rebate?

1. Apply to reserve funds at the program's website or toll-free number.
2. Buy an eligible ENERGY STAR product.
3. Complete the application and mail the required materials within 14 days of the reservation. Information on required materials is available on www.KYappliance rebates.com or by calling 1-877-813-3669.

NOTE: The website and the customer service number will open for reservations and questions starting April 22, 2010.

Residents who purchase qualified ENERGY STAR appliances on or after April 22 but did not reserve a rebate may still be eligible if funds are available.

Q & A

Can I apply for other rebates on the same appliance?

Yes, but keep in mind that each rebate sponsor has unique rules and application instructions. All mailed Kentucky rebate application materials become the state's property and will not be returned. Because original receipts may be required for other promotions, copies are recommended for Kentucky's program.

May I purchase my appliance online?

No, online purchases do not qualify for a rebate.

Is appliance recycling required to qualify?

Because this is an appliance replacement program, participants must agree to replace existing appliances with a new ENERGY STAR qualified model. Recycling is strongly encouraged. Arrangements can be made through retailers at the time of purchase.

Terms & Conditions

Only ENERGY STAR product models in the specific categories listed above are eligible for Kentucky's rebates. To determine a product model's ENERGY STAR certification, Kentucky's agents will use product information available to the public at www.ENERGYSTAR.gov. Substitutions of products or product categories are not allowed. By applying for a rebate and subsequently failing to satisfy each of the program requirements, an applicant gives up rights to the rebate and those rebate funds will no longer be available to him/her. Purchases of products that are used, rebuilt, rented, leased, exchanged, won as a prize or purchased at auction or online auction are not eligible. Cards are issued by Citibank, N.A. pursuant to a license from Visa U.S.A. Inc and managed by Citi Prepaid Services. Cards will not have cash access can be used everywhere Visa debit cards are accepted. The rights to a rebate or a rebate application may not be transferred or sold. Retailers may not apply for Kentucky's energy rebate. Applications in excess of the limits are not allowed. Applications exceeding verifiable eligible purchases are not allowed. Fraud of any type could result in federal prosecution under the US mail fraud statutes. Kentucky is not responsible for lost, late, damaged, illegible, misdirected or postage-due applications. Resolution of any disputes will be governed by Kentucky law.
